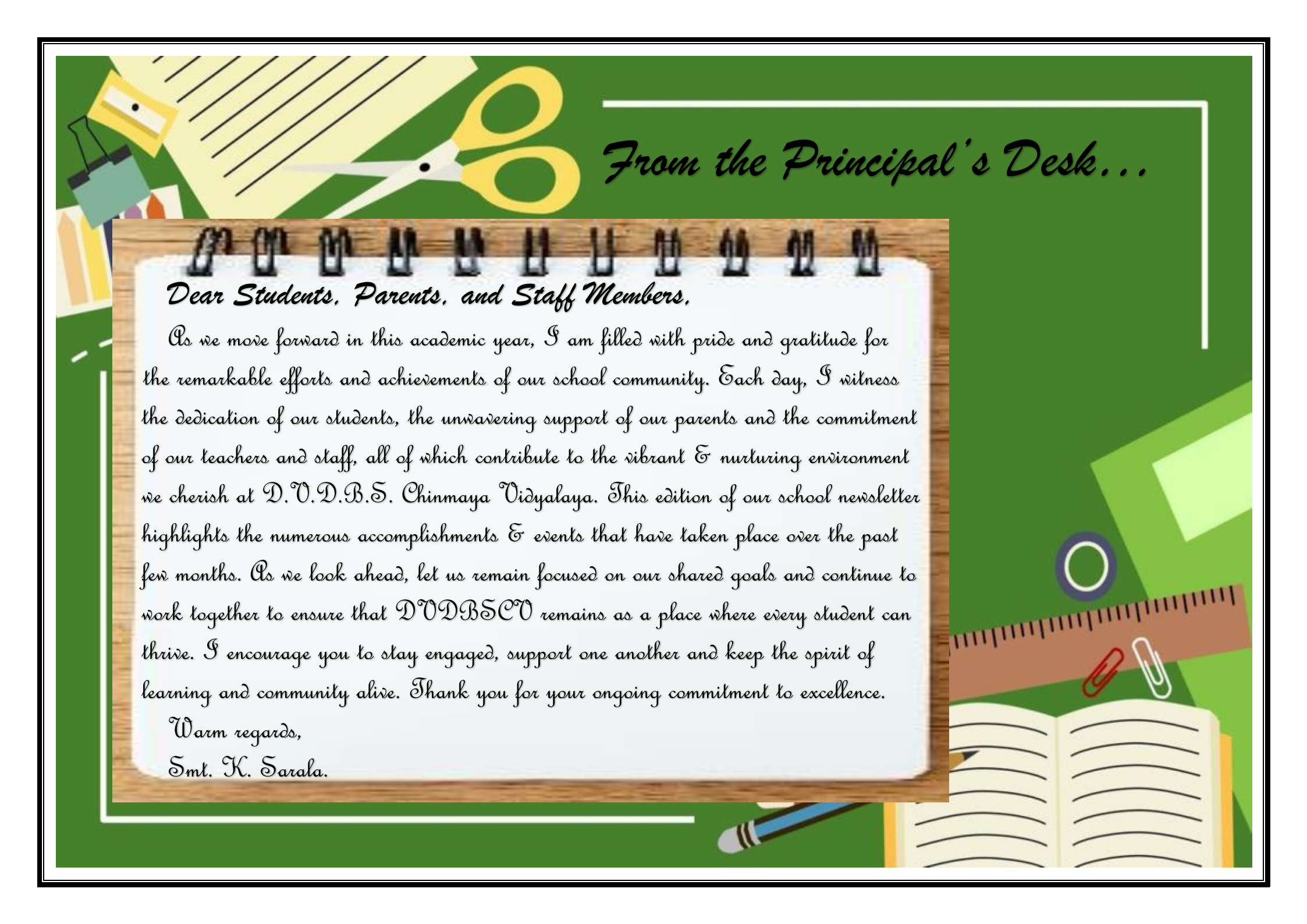

INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY



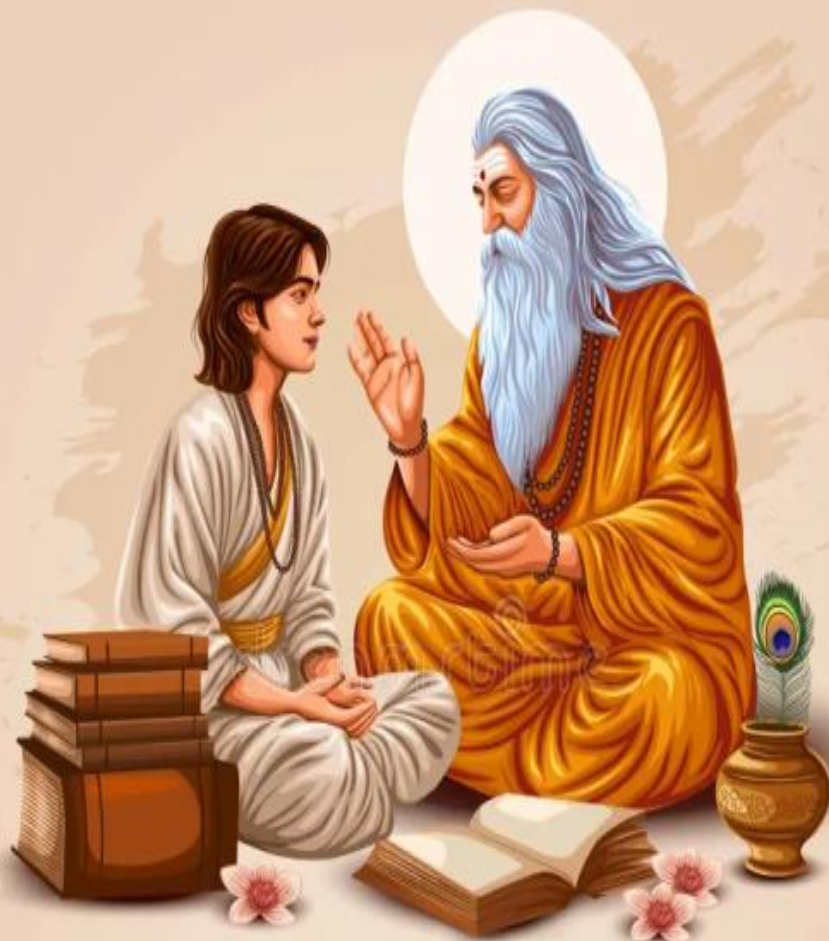

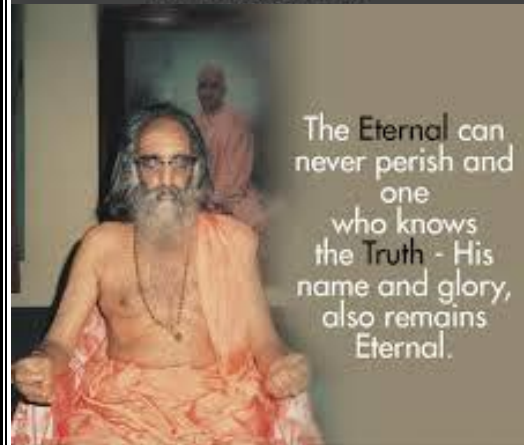
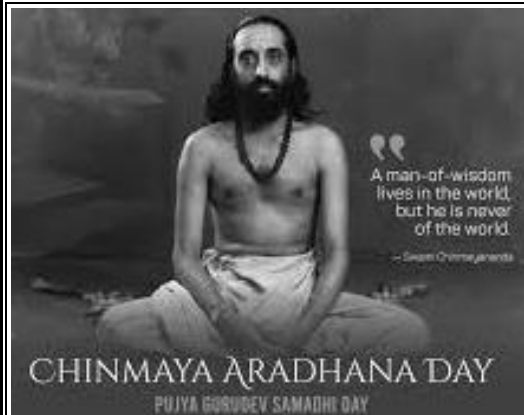
aksharaabhyasaam ceremony

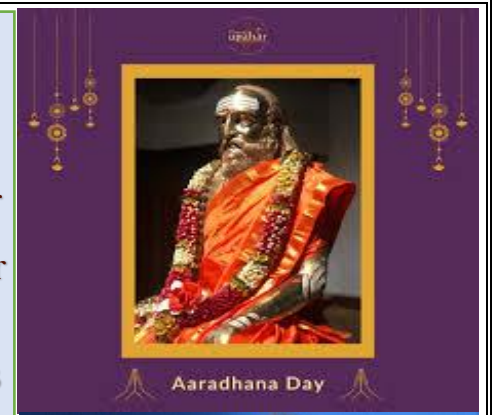

A Tribute to Our Nation On August 15th

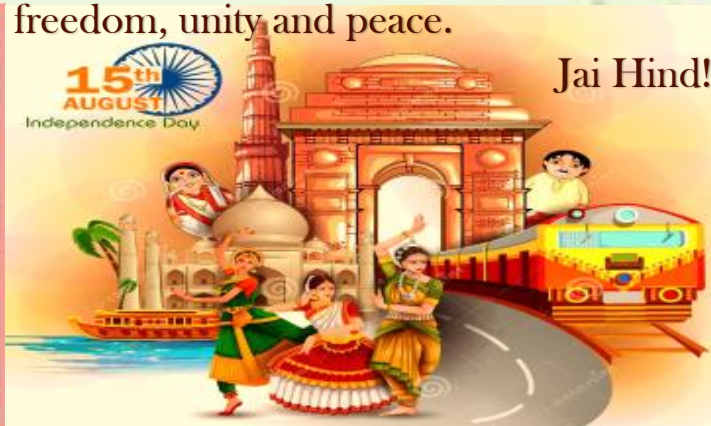

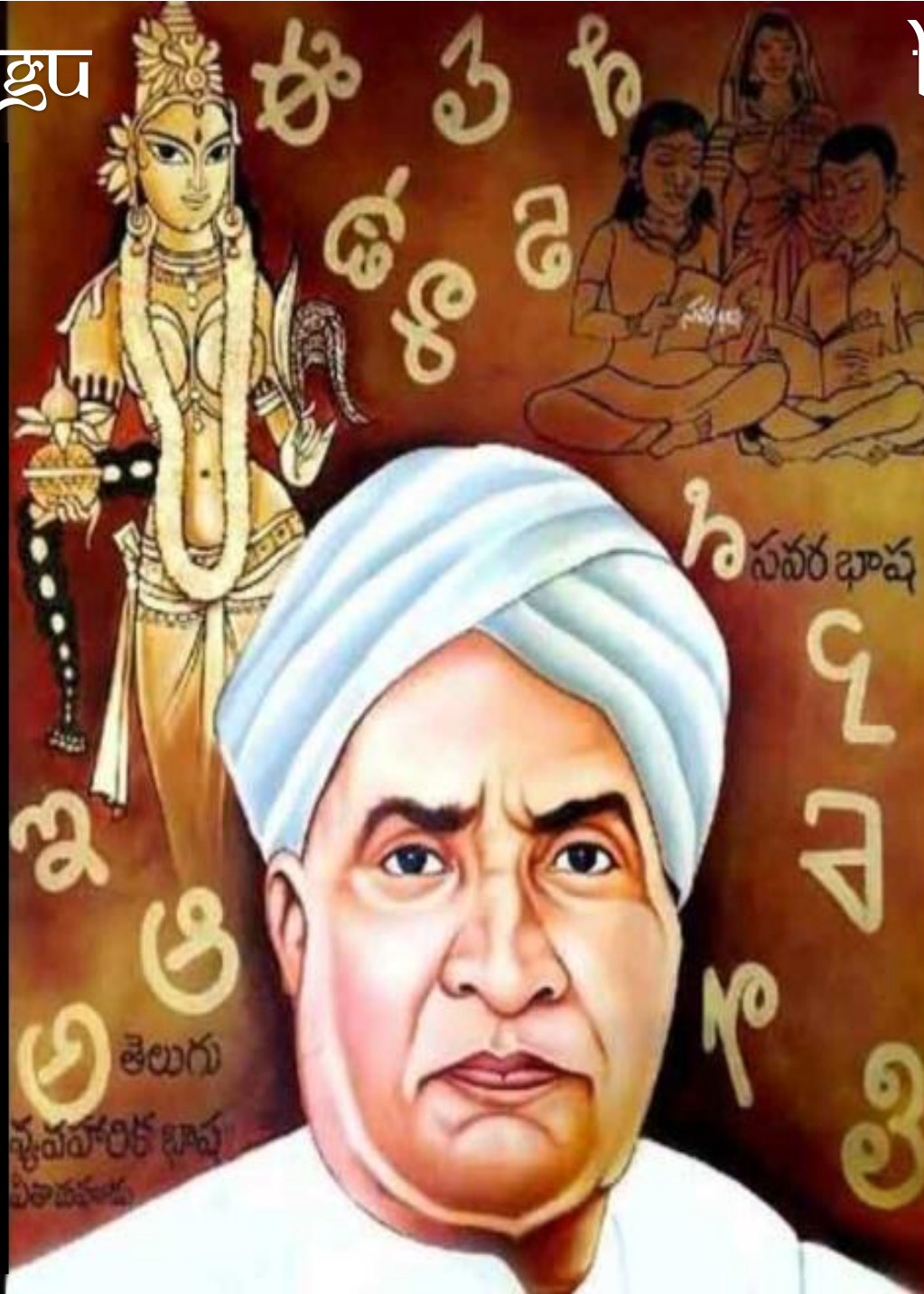
The event reminded us all of the vital role sports play in building character, discipline and resilience. Let's continue to embrace the spirit of sportsmanship in our everyday lives!

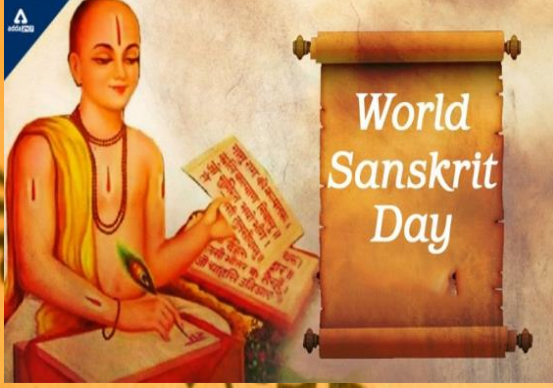

KRISHNASHTAMI CELEBRATIONS

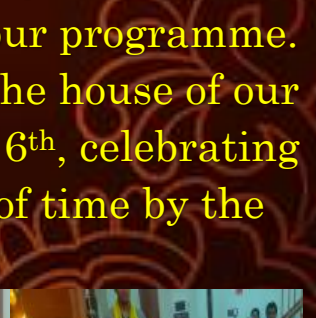
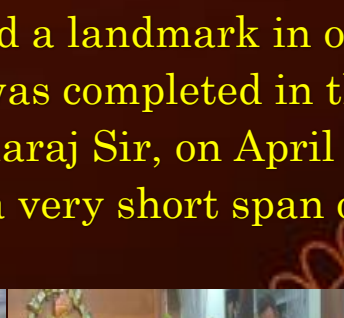
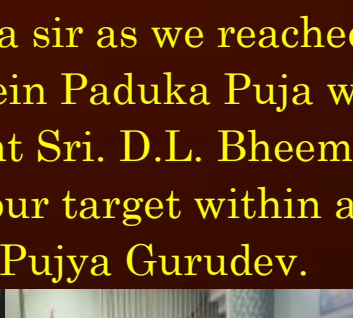
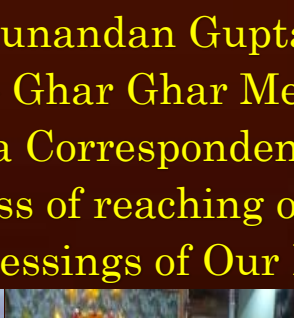

BHAGAVAD GITA INTER-SCHOOL LEVEL COMPETITION

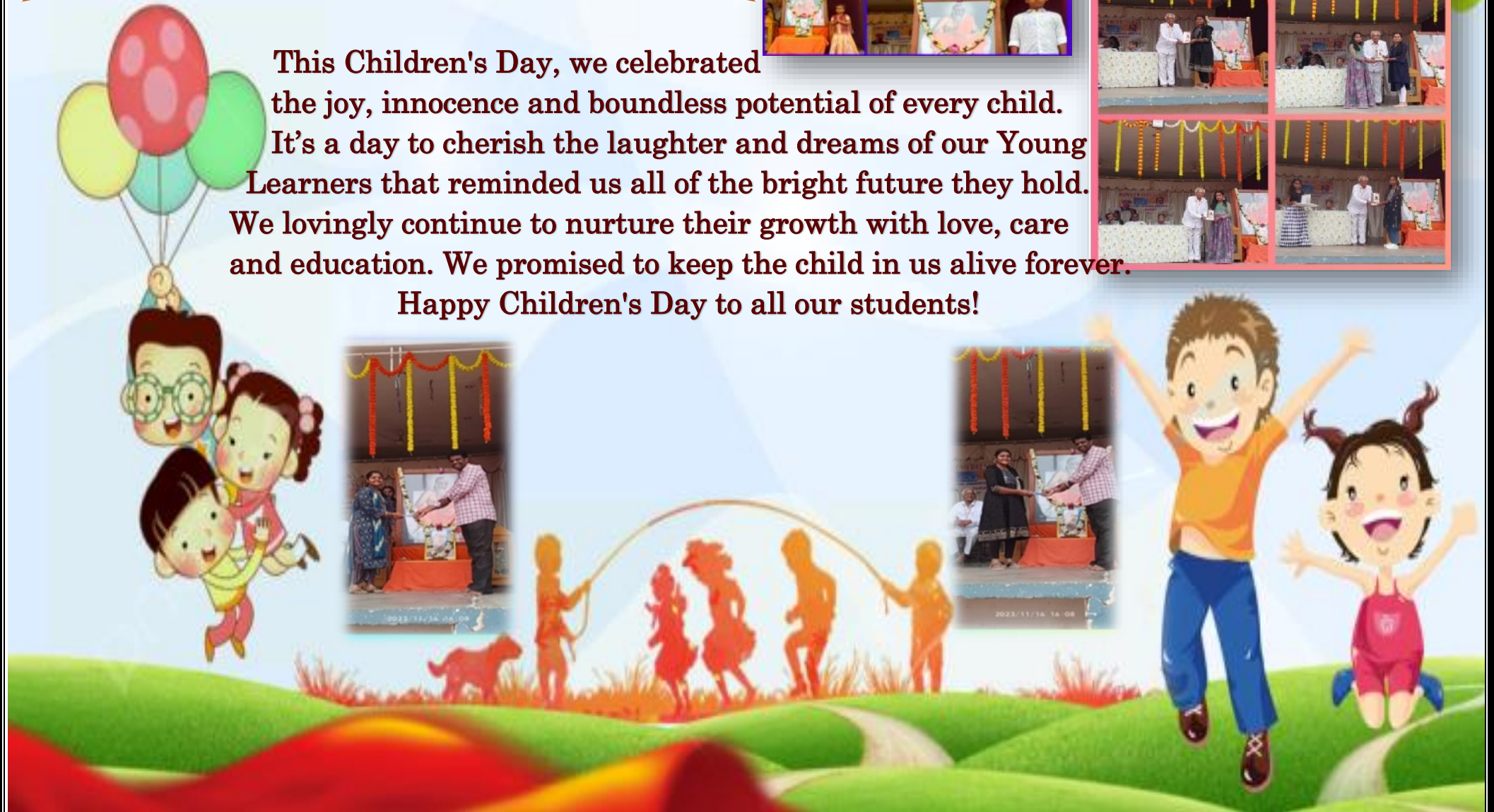

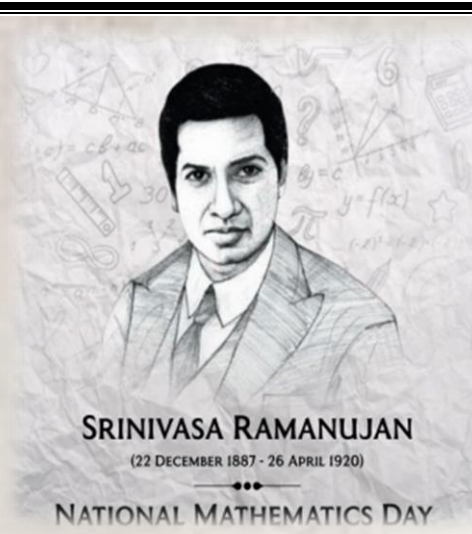


NCC DAY CELEBRATION (26TH NOV'23) SCOUTS INVESTITURE DAY

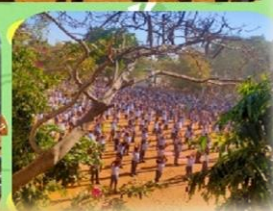
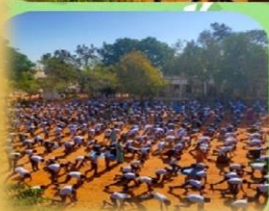
SCHOOL FOUNDER'S DAY (February 1st)

સરસ્વતી પૂજા (March 13th)

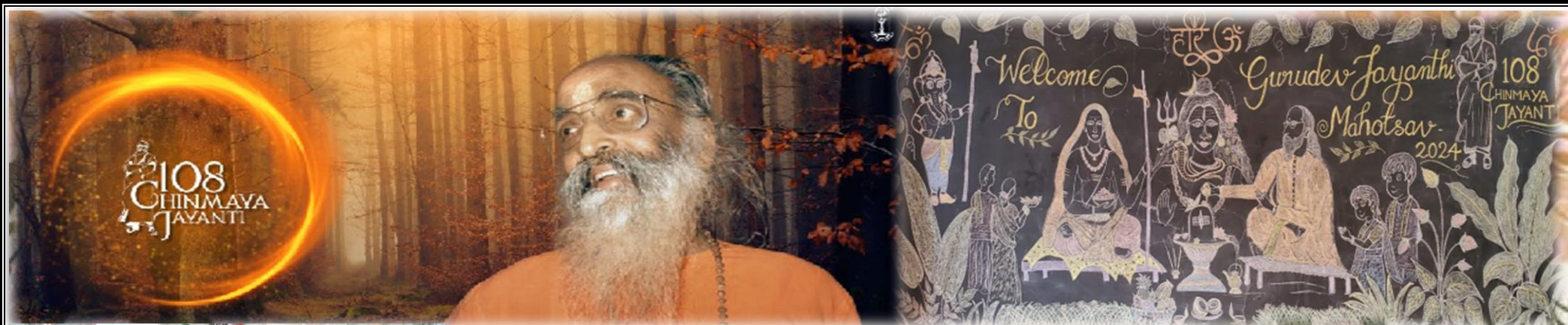
